## 2012 John Relly Beard Lecture



This year's lecture will be delivered by Rev. Peter Owen-Jones, who grew up in Southern England and spent time working in the Advertising Industry until he was ordained in the Anglican faith in 1992. He has written several books and recently has presented some highly acclaimed documentaries for the BBC including *Around the World in Eighty Faiths*, *Extreme Pilgrim* and more recently *How to Live a Simple Life*. More recently he has been concentrating on the issues around Christianity and the environment. He is the founder of the Arbory Trust, the only nominally Christian woodland burial site in the UK and earlier this year set up the Life Cairn Project which is a memorial to all the species that have become extinct as a result of human behaviour. In May 2011 he spoke at the Schumacher College in Dartington when the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Rabindranath Tagore was celebrated in a week-long festival.
