	Make a pattern using leaf stencils and use it to frame an autumn picture.
	Talk about caring for the elderly and make a list of things you could do to help them.
	Take a nature walk to look at the trees in autumn and collect specimens to either make a nature table or a collage.
	Use paint and crayons for a foggy day picture and talk about how you feel going out in foggy weather.
	Plant some bulbs and make a chart to follow their growth.
	Learn a song or poem to sing or recite in a Harvest Service.
	Make a bonfire or firework picture using different paint techniques and talk about safety precautions.
	Find out about other autumn festivities, eg Diwali, Eid, Sukkot and their symbols or festivities.
	Make some decorated buns for some children's charity, sell them to the congregation and send the proceeds to the charity.
	Use vegetables to do some printing.
	Understand the changes in Autumn, eg weather, migration of birds, or hibernation of animals.
	Any other appropriate activity for the season of Autumn.

	Go on a Nature Walk with tape recorder and play back the sounds for someone to try to recognise.
	Hear about the history of Pancake Day and help to make some pancakes.
	Make a big collage of young animals in Spring.

	Make a big summer picture of the seaside or the countryside.
	Take a part in a Flower Service or other special service for the summer.
	Listen to the story of "The Hungry Caterpillar" and make some stick puppets to dramatise the story for other children or adults.
	Talk about the trees, flowers and birds we can see in the summer and take a nature walk to see if you can find any of them.
	Listen to some music from another country and make up a dance to accompany it.
	Write a summer holiday story together.
	Any other appropriate activity for the season Summer.

	Put together an illustrated booklet about animals in winter time.
	Hear about other winter festivals and make a big representative poster or picture.
	Make some Christmas decorations to decorate a Christmas tree for the church or room.
