



USEFUL INFO FOR ATTENDEES

Attending the Unitarian Annual Meetings 2022? In this document you can find useful info ahead of your arrival in Birmingham. [For more detailed info, have a look at the Annual Meetings Handbook.](#)

Parking – Parking is by availability only. You can purchase a parking permit for £15, which will cover the duration of the conference. [Please visit the website for more information.](#)

Arrival – Please come to the main entrance. You should then register at the Annual Meetings Registration Desk for the conference. Bedrooms are available from 3pm and room keys should be collected from the Hotel Reception Desk.

Wifi – There is free wifi available throughout the hotel. To use the hotel's wifi, please connect to network **LOBBY** using the password **LOBBY** – if you have problems connecting, please contact the hotel rather than GA Staff.

Cash – There is a cash machine on site, but there is a fee for withdrawing cash. There are free cash machines in the nearby NEC buildings, but otherwise please remember to bring whatever cash you think you will need.

Drinks – The main bar is open 24 hours. There is a 20% discount on drinks if you show your conference badge. You are welcome to bring your own drinks to consume in your room if you wish. Outside your room, only drinks purchased from the venue should be consumed. Please be aware that the bedrooms do not have fridges, and therefore it is not recommended that fresh food be brought.

Take a break! - Everyone needs a break, and possibly some fresh air, every now and again. There is a small, quiet wooded area behind the hotel where you can go to relax. The lake behind the hotel is also a nice place for a walk. If you need some supplies, there are shops in the NEC. We've provided a map of the immediate area showing these. The hotel also has a spa, sauna and swimming pool.
