

## **Terms and Conditions**

### **General:**

By booking, you agree to follow the reasonable procedures and instructions of the Organisers.

You must comply with the rules and regulations governing the Venue. If you bring any property to the Venue, you do so at your own risk.

We are not responsible for any loss and/or damage to such property.

If you are using car parking facilities at the Venue, you do so entirely at your own risk. We do not accept any responsibility for any loss and/or damage resulting from your use of such car parking facilities.

# **Cancellation Policy:**

Refunds can only be made with a minimum of six weeks' notice before the first day of the Meetings. We recommend that you arrange for cancellation insurance if you wish to have it.

#### **Substitutions:**

Substitutions may be possible, at our discretion, subject to it being a like-for-like ticket replacement. For example, we would not be able to substitute a Standard Ticket for a Child's Ticket. We are also unable to substitute bookings for single rooms with existing bookings for room sharing. Substitutions can only be requested up to three weeks before the first day of the Meetings.

It is your responsibility to find an alternative person to substitute with. If you do, it is your decision whether to gift your booking or ask them to repay you for your costs. We will not refund. ### **Behaviour:**
